



## Torrington wellness center receives award from federal health agency



TORRINGTON – Community Health and Wellness Center has received the National Quality Leader Award from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration.

The health administration oversees the country’s more than 1,300 health centers, which serve more 27 million Americans annually.

The National Quality Leader Award is bestowed for exceeding national quality benchmarks, Healthy People 2020 goals, or other critical thresholds in chronic disease management, preventive care, prenatal care and perinatal care.
