COMMUNITY HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER HOSTING WORLD AIDS DAY EVENT, OFFERS FDA-APPROVED ONCE-DAILY PILL TO PREVENT HIV

TORRINGTON, CT, November 29—Community Health and Wellness Center (CHWC) is hosting a World AIDS Day event on Tuesday, December 4th, at its Torrington location at 469 Migeon Avenue.

The day offers an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, show support for people living with HIV, and commemorate those who have died from an AIDS-related illness. CHWC will be recognizing World AIDS Day with a t-shirt give away (while supplies last), raffles, information, and—as always—free and confidential HIV testing. CHWC is also relaunching its "Let's talk about PrEP" program, which offers a medication that prevents HIV. Attendees at the event who ask about PrEP will receive a free pair of Ear buds.

World AIDS Day is marking its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and the theme for 2018 is "Know your status." According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), 1,122,900 people in the United States are living with HIV, and one in seven does not know it. And there are approximately 10,400 people living in Connecticut with HIV. CHWC encourages everyone in the community to know their status by offering free and confidential HIV testing. Results of the test are known in 20 minutes, no appointment is necessary, and you do not need to be a patient to be tested. CHWC recommends everyone be tested yearly to reduce the risk of transmission and late-stage diagnosis, which can lead to AIDS.

CHWC also offers PrEP, management of the FDA-approved pill, which is taken daily to prevent HIV. When taken as prescribed, Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) has been shown to be up to 96% - 99% effective in preventing HIV infection.

HIV stands for human immunodeficiency virus. It weakens a person's immune system by destroying important cells that fight disease and infection. No effective cure exists for HIV, but with proper medical care it can be controlled.
